**INCIDENT:** Robbery Arrest

**DETAILS:**

Allegedly, McClain walked into the Whole Foods Market and asked a cashier for change. Once the cash register was opened, McClain lunged over the counter and shoved his hands into the cash drawer in an attempt to remove the cash from within. The cashier slammed the cash drawer into McClain's fingers several times until he removed his hands and fled the store. McClain got into a Black 2004 Toyota Camry that was waiting outside and was being driven by Jordan. An extensive investigation immediately after the robbery by members of the West Windsor Police Department led to the arrest of both subjects without incident.

McClain will be committed to the Mercer County Correctional Center on \$100,000 Full Bail. Jordan at this time will be committed to the Mercer County Corrections Center on \$50,000 Bail.

Both men are suspected to be involved in a string of similar robberies plaguing the Mercer County Area.
