INCIDENT: 2012-2247 Poss. Of Phencyclidine, Poss. of Marijuana under 50 grams, DWI

DETAILS: On the above listed date and time Ptl. VanNess stopped a green 2000 Volkswagon for speeding while traveling on U.S. Route 1 Southbound. Upon meeting the driver later identified as Melissa Cintron- Walker. Ptl. VanNess after speaking with the driver and observing the driver during his interview requested that Cintron- Walker exit her vehicle and perform field sobriety test. Cintron-Walker subsequently failed the field sobriety test and was placed under arrest for DWI. She also received summonses for Speeding, and Reckless Driving.

Further investigation at the scene determined the passenger of the vehicle, Errick Bryan Riddick to be in possession of PCP and under 50 grams of Marijuana. A cigarette dipped in PCP and a small bag of Marijuana under 50 grams was recovered from the vehicle. Riddick was charged with Possession of PCP and Possession of under 50 grams of Marijuana.
