INCIDENT: CDS Marijuana Arrest Case # 2012 - 0919

DATE & TIME OCCURRED: Tuesday, 01-10-2012 @ 0234 hours

LOCATION OCCURRED: Route 1 NB near Carnegie Center Boulevard

WHO: (ARRESTED, INJURED, DRIVER, VICTIM, OTHER)

Accused: Ronny T. Ung 21 years of age, New Brunswick, NJ

OFFICER: Ptl. Ted Hojnacki

DETAILS: On the above date and time, Ptl. Hojnacki observed a maroon Mercedes Benz with a headlight out traveling at high rate of speed on Route 1. Upon stopping the vehicle near Carnegie Boulevard, Ptl. Hojnacki met with the driver later identified as Ronny T. Ung. While speaking with Ung, Hojnacki detected an odor of marijuana coming from inside of the vehicle. Upon further investigation, Ptl. Hojnacki found suspected marijuana in the vehicle. Ung was subsequently placed under arrest and charged with possession of marijuana. Ung was also issued summonses for Maintenance of Lamps, Speeding and Possession of CDS in a vehicle. Ung was later released pending a future court date.
